Users will begin by selecting a “track” which best suits their needs (e.g. Catholic School (CS) Track, Youth Ministry (YM) Track, etc.). Generally, this will be determined by what ministry they serve in. The following is the structure of a track:

Tracks (have multiple)

Workshops (generally 3+; which each have multiple)

Segments (generally 5-7; which each have a)

Task (Which usually consists of one short video and a typed response to a question.)

There are also MANY extra “elective” workshops that are not found in any of the tracks, and every workshop can be searched for and engaged separate from a track.

Users may engage multiple tracks and workshops at once and do not need to complete any particular track or workshop to gain access to any others.

Some workshops are found in multiple tracks. When a workshop is completed in one track, it is marked as completed in every other track in which it is found. Therefore, it will not need to be completed again if encountered in another track.

In order to receive “credit” for completion of each workshop, something must be entered into every text field and submitted. For those working through workshops or tracks as a group/cohort, simply inputting and submitting “*Discussed with my cohort*” will suffice.
